Chenega Enterprise Systems & Solutions, LLC (ChESS) is an Alaska Native Owned SBA-Certified 8(a) Small Disadvantaged Business focused on providing professional services and information technology support to US Federal Agencies. ChESS is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Chenega Corporation. The backbone of our delivery model is the sophisticated Chenega corporate HR, Finance and Quality Management systems and \$200M line of credit. We apply small business operating agility and advanced resources to adopt our customer's mission and consistently deliver high quality, low risk solutions.

Past Performance

ChESS has successfully envisioned, developed, and implemented many SharePoint platforms for a variety of Federal Agencies. We are currently leading the migration of 60 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) sites from SharePoint on-premises to SharePoint online and evolving platforms for other Agencies into matrices of interoperable systems and support functions. Our extensive experience providing a wide range of SharePoint services and support equips us to meet Federal agencies' current and future needs.

Center for Surveillance, Epidemiology, and Laboratory Services (CSELS) / Information Resources Unit (IRU) Support Services and SharePoint Online (GS00Q17GWD2028 / 75D30120F07194; \$9.7M; 4/1/2020 – 3/31/2024):

We perform full lifecycle SharePoint site development and support, including installation, configuration, migration, and optimization; develop and implement processes, methods, tools, and artifacts designed to collect, record, aggregate, track, and report relevant SharePoint information; and design and manage effective content management and archive standards, processes, tools, and techniques. Additionally, Chenega designs and manages the CSELS Solutions Suite toolkit, an all-encompassing technology, security, information, data, and interoperability architecture.

Upon completion of the rebuild and migration of SharePoint sites for the CSELS IRU Division of Public Health Information Dissemination (DPHID), our on-premise technical skills and expertise led to a 25% reduction in sites, 43% reduction in security groups, 50% reduction in lists, 75% reduction in the size of site collection, and 75% reduction in stored site files. To date, we have simplified content and navigation and improved scalability and performance by developing or updating ~95 SharePoint and real business technology solutions; maintaining ~330 SharePoint sites and their respective ~1,500 permission groups; managing over 100GB of SharePoint content across all environments; resolving ~3,500 support tickets for ~310 unique customers throughout CSELS; and transitioning ~2,700 CSELS intranet files, streamlining and consolidating them into ~15 SharePoint pages.

the two Divisions' share drive sites and SharePoint sites, which includes the customizing and implementing division-level business, science, policy, program, and communication applications with the ability to scale to the center or enterprise-level. We plan, develop, implement, and support integrated architecture that considers current and desired future state of SharePoint within OSH and DOH; effective content management and archive standards, processes, tools, and techniques; and solutions that enable integration of strategy, portfolio, contracts, budgets, staffing, tactical project schedules, and related reporting and analytics, supporting decision making at all levels of OSH and DOH from one integrated management solution. All services are coordinated across both Divisions and our team leads regular group meetings and information gathering sessions with senior-level executives and staff. Additionally, we make recommendations for improvements and incorporating best practices into site administration and development activities.

Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Training Division (TD) Support (DJF-16-1200-S-0007512; \$12.5M; 9/26/2016 – 9/25/2021): Similarly, we provide SharePoint administration, web development, and other related services to the FBI Training Division (TD). We build and administer SharePoint sites, libraries, and web pages using HTML, XML, CSS and additional web development tools as required; oversee 508 compliance regulations and technical details; and maintain a standardized site architecture that meets all security, permissions, portal access, collaboration and communication requirements. Chenega personnel work with the FBI TD to apply knowledge of search engines, MS.NET, and meta-tagging technology to develop and document systems, interfaces and products. Weekly meetings are conducted to discuss progress, constraints, and upcoming projects and tasks. Complementing our SharePoint support, Chenega also provides in-depth training on SharePoint capabilities to FBI staff. Additional support includes updates and adjustments to the TD database for compatibility with updated rubric applications, including installation of rubric application software on instructor tablets, and modifying database operations to provide added capability to gather all necessary data to develop and incorporate additional rubrics from different TD units, ensuring rubric app compatibility across training unit databases. Over 400 personnel have been granted access and regularly use the sites to date.

Additional Experience

In addition to the experience above, we have completed over \$25M in SharePoint support services throughout the Department of Defense (DoD), National Center for Emerging and Zoonotic Infectious Diseases (NCEZID), U.S. Air Force, and Navy U.S. Fleet Forces Command (USFF). Directed Award Contracting Option

A sole source procurement to ChESS under the provisions of FAR 19.805-1(b)(2) and 13 CFR 124.506(b) provides a streamlined and flexible procurement strategy.
